

Privacy Policy

BRUNSDON CAPITAL ("BRC") controls the information it collects from its customers, including information obtained through BRC's website (the "Site"). According to regulations, BRC regards the protection, privacy and security of personal and financial information of customers and website visitors as our top priority.

This privacy statement outlines BRC's Privacy Policy and describes how BRC ensures that all personal information it collects is kept confidential and how BRC always respects and protects personal privacy. By opening an account or using the Website, Customer agrees to BRC's collection and use of Personal Information as described in this Privacy Statement.

Collection and use of personal information BRC obtain detailed information about each customer in order to verify identity and assess whether the client is suitable for opening a trading account. The information collected includes personal identification, physical address and email address, phone number, date of birth, position, passport, and other detailed identification information, as well as personal financial information (including annual income and approximate net asset value used to assess the financial status of the customer). In addition, BRC will collect additional information to better evaluate the client's unique interests for the purpose of customization and general marketing purposes. Affiliates and partners

BRC may, from time to time, establish partnerships and alliances with other parties, which may include joint marketing and alliance agreements with other companies that provide valuable products and services to BRC's clients. To provide a product or service requested by a customer, or to provide a customer with an opportunity to utilize the products or services offered by a partner or affiliate, or to ensure that products and services meet the needs of the customer and are provided in an effective and relevant manner.

BRC may share information with its partners or affiliates. Customer's personal information is limited to the purposes identified by the relationship between BRC and the partner or affiliate.

BRC will not sell, license, lease or otherwise disclose any customer's personal information to any third party for any reason, except in the following cases:

- At the request of regulatory authorities, law enforcement agencies or other government agencies;
- to protect the rights or property of BRC (if necessary);



- To help improve the services provided to customers, BRC may ask another company to assist with internal functions such as account processing, order fulfilment, customer service and customer satisfaction surveys, or provide other support services or data collection related to BRC business activity.
